F. GENERAL PROVISIONS:

Encroachment Permit can only be issued to Licensed Contractor. In consideration of the granting of this permit and other good and valuable consideration, the undersigned and the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the undersigned, agree that permittee shall be responsible for all liability imposed by law for personal injury or property damage proximately caused by failure on permittee's part to perform his/her obligations under this permit in respect to maintenance. If any claim of such liability is made against the City of Milpitas, its officers, employees, or agents, permittee shall defend, indemnify and hold them, and each of them harmless from such claim. Nothing herein is intended to impose any different or higher standards or care than that required from by law. Permittee agrees to the following:

- 1) To remove encroachment at its expense when notified in writing by the City where necessary for City purposes.
- 2) That the City has the right to remove the encroachment at its own expense without compensation to the permit holder if necessary for any City purposes.
- 3) That the City is not responsible for any repair or maintenance of this encroachment for any reason.
- 4) That any existing facilities damaged or removed shall be replaced in kind or better, including but not limited to replacing existing striping. Water based paint shall be used for all temporary markings on concrete or asphaltic pavement or other structures. All temporary markings shall be completely removed by the contractor when they are no longer required and prior to final inspection.
- 5) Any misrepresentation of information requested from the permittee on this form shall make this permit null and void.
- 6) That the encroachment shall not obstruct access to any water meter or any other City facility.
- 7) That the hours of work shall be limited to 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday (except holidays), unless otherwise approved by the City Engineer.
- 8) The permittee shall call Underground Service Alert (USA) 48 hours prior to construction at 1-(800) 642-2444.
- 9) The permittee shall maintain a copy of this permit at job site for review when requested.
